

ORDINANCE NO. 88-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SPECIAL USE PERMIT GRANTED TO
COLUMBIA GAS OF OHIO, INC. TO ALLOW FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A 10' X 10'
EQUIPMENT SHED TO BE LOCATED AT 33556 AVON ROAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, zoning regulations for the City of Avon, viz., ACO §1262.03(b)(7) require public utility substations located in an R-1 zoning district to obtain a Special Use Permit pursuant to ACO §1280.04(o); and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 1993, Council passed Ordinance No. 89-93 allowing for the construction of a regulator building at 33556 Avon Road in an R-1 residential district; and

WHEREAS, Columbia Gas wants to construct a 10' x 10' equipment shed as an addition to the existing regulator building requiring an amendment to their existing special use permit; and

WHEREAS, Columbia Gas submitted plans and specifications for the construction of this 10' x 10' equipment shed at 33556 Avon Road to the Avon Planning Commission on July 20, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Planning Commission held a public hearing on July 20, 2016 and by a vote of five (5) in favor and zero (0) opposed, recommended to Council the granting of said amendment to the Special Use Permit for the construction of the additional 10' x 10' equipment shed; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the plans and specifications for the proposed improvements as submitted and the recommendation of Planning Commission, Council deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the city that the Special Use Permit be granted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That having considered the matter of granting an amendment to the Special Use Permit for Columbia Gas to construct a 10' x 10' equipment shed as an addition to the existing regulator building at property they own at 33556 Avon Road, Council hereby accepts the recommendation of Planning Commission and agrees to grant the amended Special Use Permit for Columbia Gas pursuant to plans and specifications submitted to Planning Commission on July 20, 2016 and subject to the conditions set forth in this ordinance.

Section 2 - Conditions. 1) That the project proceed pursuant to plans and specifications approved and recommended by the Planning Commission on July 20, 2016; and 2) that the amended Special Use Permit granted herein for the construction of a 10' x 10' equipment shed is conditioned upon applicant meeting all applicable requirements of the Avon Codified Ordinances including, but not limited to, those set forth in 1280.02, 1280.03, 1280.04(o) and 1280.06(bb). Any expansion, development, enlargement, improvement, change in ownership, use or the life, other than maintenance of the property in its current condition, will require an additional amendment to this Special Use Permit, with a recommendation of Planning Commission and approval by City Council.

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Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend the Special Use Permit for Columbia Gas to construct a 10' x 10' equipment shed at 33556 Avon Road; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
