3. MAYORAL REAPPOINTMENT OF MICHAEL BULGER TO THE BOARD OF ZONING AND BUILDING APPEALS

Mayor Jensen announces his reappointment of Michael Bulger to the Board of Zoning and Building Appeals for another five-year term from January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2029.

Per Charter Article VII, Section 1(a), this five-year appointment requires the concurrence of two-thirds of the membership of the legislative authority.

4. MAYORAL REAPPOINTMENT OF ALEX BOCCABELLA TO THE TREE COMMISSION

Mayor Jensen announces his reappointment of Alex Boccabella to the Tree Commission for another five-year term from January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2029.

Per Section 2 of Ordinance No. 70-21, the Mayor reappoints Alex Boccabella as a voting member of the Tree Commission for a five-year term beginning January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2029.

This appointment does not require the concurrence of City Council.

5. MAYORAL REAPPOINTMENT OF CYNTHIA MURNYACK-CZARNECKI TO THE LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMISSION AS THE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE GARDEN CLUB

Mayor Jensen announces his reappointment of Cynthia Murnyack-Czarnecki to the Landmarks Preservation Commission as the representative from the Garden Club for another four-year term from January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2028.

Per Charter Article XIV, Section 1(a), this four-year appointment requires the concurrence of a majority of the membership of the legislative authority.

R-02-25](#) – SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV, SECTION 17 OF THE AVON CITY CHARTER AND CHAPTER 718 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE QUESTION OF AMENDING SECTIONS 881.01, 881.03, AND 881.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY TO INCREASE THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX RATE FROM 1.75% TO 1.95% FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR CAPITAL AND OPERATING EXPENDITURES OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF AVON AND TO AMEND SECTION 881.06 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY TO INCREASE THE CREDIT FOR MUNICIPAL INCOME TAXES PAID BY RESIDENTS OF THE CITY TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY FROM 1.50% TO 1.70%
