

ORDINANCE NO. 83-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE FULL DEPTH PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT THE AVON FIRE STATION LOCATED AT 36185 DETROIT ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-18-13, bids were advertised to complete the full depth pavement rehabilitation at the Avon Fire Station located at 36185 Detroit Road; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Service Director, the City Engineer and Bramhall Engineering & Surveying Company, Inc. recommend acceptance of the bid submitted by Terminal Ready Mix, Inc. in the amount of Ninety Two Thousand Twenty-Seven Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$92,027.00) as the lowest and best bid received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - The bid submitted by Terminal Ready Mix, Inc. in the amount of Ninety Two Thousand Twenty-Seven Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$92,027.00) is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid received. Council hereby authorizes the Finance Director to advance funds from the Fire Department Equipment Fund No. 106 to meet the obligations incurred herein. Further the Finance Director is authorized to increase the appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in

such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to award the bid for the full depth pavement rehabilitation at the Avon Fire Station located at 36185 Detroit Road; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.
