

RESOLUTION NO. R-3-13

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S (ODOT) SAFETY RECOMMENDATION FOR THE CHESTER ROAD RELOCATION AT STATE ROUTE 611, PID NO. 94622 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a Safety Study conducted by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has the State of Ohio and the City of Avon considering improvements to the intersection of State Route 611 and Chester Road; and

WHEREAS, the grant for this project was recently approved by ODOT and requires the City to express its support for the future funding of this project; and

WHEREAS, Council hereby desires to express its support for this project because it will significantly further the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and the motoring public by improving the intersection of State Route 611 and Chester Road by aligning Chester Road with Recreation Lane at a relatively small cost to the City and thereby create a smoother and safer flow of traffic on these major thoroughfares.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City supports the efforts of the Ohio Department of Transportation to implement the results of its safety study at and in the vicinity of State Route 611, Chester Road, Recreation Lane and I-90 and will seriously consider funding the City's portion of the cost of these improvements as set forth in the attached exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to express support for the results of the ODOT safety study for St. Rt. 611 and Chester Rd.; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
