

RESOLUTION NO. R-01-16

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE
CHESTER ROAD WIDENING AT S.R. 83 PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to current and projected increased traffic in and around the area of State Route 83 and Chester Road, it is necessary for the City to improve Chester Road to accommodate said traffic by expanding the number of lanes east and west bound between Route 83 and the site of the future Menards; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that the following road will be improved at the following location: Chester Road starting at Center Road (S.R. 83) and then extending east approximately 1,325 linear feet. The project shall consist of the following components: widening of both the North and South roadway for a five (5) lane wide asphalt pavement cross-section with concrete curb and gutter, reconstruction of portions of existing storm sewer system, replacement of portions of existing water main, asphalt pedestrian path, concrete sidewalk and curb ramps, driveway apron replacements, traffic signal upgrades at the Center Road and the Walmart Drive intersection, pavement markings, signage, maintenance of traffic, miscellaneous appurtenances and restoration; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with advertising for bids to complete the Chester Road Widening Project at S.R. 83 Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for road improvements at the following location: Chester Road beginning at Center Road (S.R. 83) and extending east approximately 1,325 linear feet. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the

Chester Road Widening Project at S.R. 83 in order to possibly facilitate substantial construction prior to the end of construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
