

RESOLUTION NO. R-25-16

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REPORT OF THE ASSESSMENT
EQUALIZATION BOARD FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF A
PORTION OF CHESTER ROAD, FROM A TWO (2) LANE TO A FIVE (5) LANE ROADWAY,
TOGETHER WITH ALL APPURTENANCES AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS THERETO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Avon declared the necessity for the construction and reconstruction of a portion of Chester Road from a two (2) lane to a five (5) lane roadway together with all appurtenances and related improvements thereto pursuant to passage of a resolution of necessity, (Resolution No. R-4-16); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Avon, in Resolution No. R-6-16, appointed an Assessment Equalization Board to hear and determine all objections and to equalize such assessments as it deemed proper to conform to the standards prescribed by R-4-16 and by law; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Avon deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the taxpayers of the municipality to approve the report of the Assessment Equalization Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the report of the Assessment Equalization Board marked as Exhibit A and attached hereto and made a part of this resolution is hereby approved and accepted by Council.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to construct and reconstruct a portion of Chester Road from a two (2) lane to a five (5) lane roadway together with all appurtenances and related improvements thereto in the City of Avon; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
