

ORDINANCE NO. 95-17

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES, INC.
FOR THE COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLES, YARD WASTE AND BULK
MATERIAL FROM RESIDENTS IN THE CITY OF AVON FOR THE YEAR 2018
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City desires to facilitate a recycling program for its residents; and

WHEREAS, Republic Services, Inc. agrees to provide these services to the City pursuant to a Memorandum of Understanding during the year 2018; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed the MOU (Exhibit A) and the Bulk Week Calendar (Exhibit B), deems it desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Avon to authorize the Mayor to enter into said MOU thereby facilitating the collection of recyclables, yard waste and bulk material for the year 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City, through the office of the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Republic Services, Inc., for the collection of recyclables, yard waste and bulk material from residents of the City of Avon. Recyclables and bulk materials will be picked up beginning January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. Yard waste will be collected beginning Friday, April 13, 2018 through Friday, December 7, 2018. A copy of the Memorandum of Understanding and the calendar of "Bulk Weeks" are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B," respectively.

Section 2 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Republic Services, Inc. to provide removal of recyclables, residential yard waste and bulk material in an effort to improve the environment and to reduce the amount of solid waste entering the waste stream and our riparian corridor, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
