

ORDINANCE NO. 111-17

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXTEND THE POLICE TOWING CONTRACT WITH HALL'S TOWING FOR AN ADDITIONAL TWO (2) YEARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution R-16-14, passed on September 8, 2014, advertised for bids to enter into a contract for towing services required by the Avon Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Ord. No. 124-14, passed on October 14, 2014 awarded the bid to, and entered into a contract with, Hall's Towing, Inc., 6451 Avon Belden Road, North Ridgeville, Ohio the sole bidder; and

WHEREAS, the contract terms were for three (3) years with a City option for two (2) one (1) year renewals with City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, Hall's has agreed to maintain all pricing set forth in the 2014 contract for an additional two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police and the City's Safety Director, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to extend the Hall's Towing contract for two (2) additional years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to extend the October, 2014 Hall's Towing, Inc. contract for an additional two (2) years to October 14, 2019 as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein by this reference. Council further authorizes the Finance Director to advance funds from the Police Department Fund No. 221 to meet the obligations incurred herein.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to extend the October 14, 2014 Police towing contract with Hall's Towing, Inc. for an additional two (2) years to October 14, 2019; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
