

ORDINANCE NO. 32-18

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE LILAC LANE, VIOLET COURT &
PERIWINKLE WAY PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear, it is deemed necessary for the City to repair, and improve Lilac Lane, Violet Court & Periwinkle Way at certain locations during the 2018 construction season; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that these roadways will be improved where recommended by the City Engineer in the following locations: Lilac Lane asphalt resurfacing will be approximately 875 feet beginning at the Lilac Lane cul-de-sac extending east to the Garden Drive intersection; Violet Court asphalt resurfacing will be approximately 825 feet along Violet Court beginning at Lilac Lane and extending south to Primrose Lane; Periwinkle Way asphalt resurfacing will be approximately 450 feet from Primrose Lane and extending west and south to the Periwinkle Way cul-de-sac; and

WHEREAS, the Administration also included other possible pavement improvements to the public bid authorized by City Council as Resolution No. 16-18 passed on March 19, 2018 as bid alternates for the following locations: Primrose Lane (Alternate #1) and Violet Court from Lilac Lane north through the cul-de-sac (Alternate #2); and

WHEREAS, the project shall consist of the following: grinding away of an existing asphalt surface to expose an existing concrete pavement layer; performance of concrete base and joint repairs where identified by the City Engineer; placement of a gravel chip seal layer; and then resurfacing with two courses of asphalt concrete pavements. Sidewalk, curb ramp and catch basin repairs will also be performed at intermittent locations along with reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, and associated lawn restoration; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on April 12, 2018 at Avon City Hall. The bids received are as follows:

WHEREAS, The Engineer’s Estimates for the Base Bid and Alternates are: \$398,700.00 Base Bid, \$72,525.00 Alternate No.1, \$143,700 Alternate No.2 and \$614,925.00 Total. As such, the bid submitted by Precision Paving, Inc. for the Base Bid and both Alternates in total is 21% below the Engineer’s Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the Base Bid plus both Alternate No.1 and Alternate No. 2 submitted by Precision Paving, Inc. be considered the lowest and best bid for the Lilac Lane, Violet Court & Periwinkle Way Pavement Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City of Avon go forward with awarding a construction contract to complete the Lilac Lane, Violet Court & Periwinkle Way Pavement Resurfacing Project as referenced above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to bids received on April 12, 2018 for the Lilac Lane, Violet Court & Periwinkle Way Pavement Resurfacing Project, the bid submitted by Precision Paving, Inc. for the Base Bid plus both Alternate No. 1 and Alternate No. 2 in the amount of Four Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand, Six Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and 50/100 Cents (\$497,657.50) is declared to be the lowest and best bid and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment in said amount from the 2018 Road Program Fund No. 407 pursuant to the contract. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the Lilac Lane, Violet Court & Periwinkle Way Pavement Resurfacing Project with both Alternates prior to the end of the 2018 construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
