

ORDINANCE NO. 79-18

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH RANGES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE
PART-TIME POSITIONS IN THE AVON SENIORS CENTER
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to various ordinances passed by City Council over the years, several part-time positions were established within the Avon Seniors Center; and

WHEREAS, these positions include the Senior Center Transit Driver, the Senior Center Scheduler, the Senior Center Transit Driver/Maintenance and the Senior Center Activity Planner; and

WHEREAS, Council set an hourly rate of pay for each of these positions at or around the time it was established; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon the recommendation of the Administration, is now considering establishing a pay range for each of these part-time unclassified positions as set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation ranges being proposed for these permanent part-time, unclassified positions to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive staff at the Avon Seniors Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That effective with the date of passage of this Ordinance, the part-time, unclassified positions in the Avon Seniors Center shall be compensated based upon the ranges established and set forth in Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by this reference, together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for these position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to establish ranges of compensation for the permanent part-time, unclassified positions in the Avon Seniors Center thus enabling the Mayor to

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increase said pay in appropriate circumstances during the course of the year; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
