

RESOLUTION NO. R-31-19

A RESOLUTION TO RE-ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE DESIGN, PERMITTING, PROVISION & INSTALLATION OF A FIRE TRAINING FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution R-16-19, passed on June 24, 2019, advertised for bids to design, permit, provide and install a Fire Training Facility; and

WHEREAS, only one bid was submitted and it exceeded the 10% limitation specified in Ohio Revised Code §153.12; and

WHEREAS City Council, on November 25, 2019, passed Ordinance No. 101-19 rejecting the bid; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer in conjunction with the Fire Department, has prepared a new bid package containing a project scope, supplemental plans, project deliverables and specifications for a design/build project delivery method to obtain the desired fire training facility installation; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with re-advertising for public bids of a design/build project delivery method for the Avon Fire Department Fire Training Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to re-advertise for public bids for a design/build project delivery method that will provide for the design, permitting, provision and installation of a Fire Training Facility on the rear parking lot south of the Avon Fire Station on Detroit Road. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer, Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. and the Avon Fire Department which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to re-advertise for bids for the Avon Fire Department Training Facility in order to expedite the training of department personnel at the earliest possible timeframe; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
