Register Your Security Camera

The Avon Police Department requests your help in deterring and fighting crime. We are asking residents and business owners with exterior surveillance (including doorbell cameras) to voluntarily register the exterior cameras with us.

We believe that Avon is a great place to live and work. As such we are constantly striving to improve our service. By registering your security cameras, you will be providing information that may prove valuable in a police investigation.

This department is not requesting direct access to your surveillance system. Information collected would allow investigators to know locations of cameras so that, if a crime occurs in that area, police can directly contact the community member for assistance.

Why register for the Camera Registration Program?

- 1) Deter criminal activity
- 2) Protect your community
- 3) Assist police investigations

Camera Registration Program goal: To deter crime and promote public safety through collaboration. All registrants agree to the following.

Conditions and Terms of Use:

- 1) The Avon Police Department does not have direct access to your surveillance system and may contact you regarding your recordings.
- 2) Any obtained footage containing or related to criminal activity may be collected and used for evidence during any stage of a criminal proceeding.
- 3) At no time shall registrants be considered employees or agents of the Avon Police Department.
- 4) Relevant information is reserved for official use by the Avon Police Department and will not be released to any member of the public or press.

Video surveillance is one of the best methods for apprehending criminals. Please consider partnering with the APD to protect our community.
