

ORDINANCE NO. 6-21

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE
MOON ROAD PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear and increased traffic, it is necessary for the City to repair and improve the pavement surface at certain locations identified by the Avon Street Superintendent and the City Engineer along Moon Road during the 2021 construction season; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-28-20 on December 14, 2020 which authorized the public bid of said project known as the Moon Road Pavement Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, said project shall consist of the following: Removal of the top portion of the existing pavement surface, full and partial depth asphalt pavement repairs at locations determined by the City Engineer, asphalt pavement resurfacing, reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, and associated restoration; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on February 4, 2021 at the Avon City Hall and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimated cost for the project was set at \$599,395.00. As such, the bid submitted by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. is approximately 24% less than the Engineer's Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto within Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. be considered the lowest and best bid for the Moon Road Pavement Resurfacing Project, a bid review memorandum is also attached hereto as part of Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with the following: awarding of a construction contract based on the public bid submitted by the Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the Moon Road Pavement Resurfacing Project, which was received on February 4, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 – That pursuant to bids received on February 4, 2021 at Avon City Hall for the Moon Road Pavement Resurfacing Project, the bid submitted by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., (no relation to Chagrin Valley Engineering), in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Seven and 50/100 Cents (\$453,707.50) for the Moon Road Pavement Resurfacing Project is declared to be the lowest and best bid and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment in said amount from the 2021 Road Program Fund No. 419. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2 – That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 – That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the Moon Road Pavement Resurfacing Project prior to the end of the 2021 construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
