

ORDINANCE NO. 29-21

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 38-15 ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE PART-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED SEASONAL CASHIER FOR THE CITY OF AVON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has previously established the part-time, unclassified position of Seasonal Cashier in '256.04 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council established a pay range for said position with Ordinance No. 38-15 which passed on March 23, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the starting pay range be amended to a sum between the then current State of Ohio Minimum Wage and Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per hour; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation being proposed for the part-time, unclassified position of Seasonal Cashier to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive workforce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 – That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 38-15 which currently reads as follows:

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance, the part-time, unclassified position of Seasonal Cashier shall be paid an hourly rate of between Eight Dollars and Ten Cents (\$8.10) and Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per hour, together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination.

shall be amended to read as follows: (New language in bold print; deleted language stricken)

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance, the part-time, unclassified position of Seasonal Cashier shall be paid **between** an hourly rate **equal to the then current State of Ohio minimum wage and Fifteen** Dollars (\$15.00) per hour. ~~together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination.~~

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of amending the range of compensation for the part-time, unclassified position of Seasonal Cashier thus maintaining a well-qualified, efficient and productive workforce; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
