

ORDINANCE NO. 99-22

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A RANGE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE FULL-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF CLERK OF COURTS FOR THE CITY OF AVON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council needs to establish a range of compensation for the full-time position of Clerk of Courts; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set compensation for this position at a level commensurate with experience and which is competitive with other municipalities so as to attract applicants with the desired qualifications and characteristics; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the starting salary for this full-time Clerk of Court's position be set between Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$20.00) and Thirty and 00/100 Dollars (\$30.00) per hour, together with all other benefits of a permanent, full-time, unclassified employee commencing with the date of hire; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation being proposed for the permanent full-time, unclassified position of Clerk of Courts to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive staff for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That upon passage of this legislation, the range of compensation for the position of Clerk of Courts shall be set between Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$20.00) and Thirty and 00/100 Dollars (\$30.00) per hour, commencing with their date of hire, in addition to all other benefits of a full-time employee as set forth in Avon Codified Ordinances Chapter 256.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position within the range set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to establish a range of compensation for the full-time position of Clerk of Courts as soon as practicable; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
